The applicant, who is in custody since 28.12.2020, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Khelgaon P.S. Case No.118 of 2020 registered for the offence under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 341 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

It appears that scuffle has taken place between the inmates of the Jail in the year 2020 for which he has been remanded in this case on 03.02.2022 although he is in custody for more than 2 years in another case.

Investigation is complete. The applicant undertakes to participate in the trial. Similarly situated co-accused has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 14.06.2022 passed in B.A. No. 4926 of 2022. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above fact and the fact that co-accused has already been granted bail, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., Ranchi, in connection with Khelgaon P.S. Case No.118 of 2020, on the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
