This bail application of Banty Singh, Sunil Kumar Paswan has been moved by Mr. Pran Pranay, learned counsel for the petitioners and opposed by Mrs. Nehala Sharmin, learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 12.02.2022 in connection with Bagbera P.S. Case No. 20 of 2022 for the offence registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 450, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25(1-B) a, 25 (1-A)/25(6)/26/27/35 of the Arms Act, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jamshedpur.

As per the prosecution case then the informant was assaulted by the accused persons with regard to land dispute. When the informant did not open the door of her house of fear, the offenders fired a number of rounds and seeing the nearby people assembling there, then ran away leaving their Scorpio vehicle at the door of the house of the informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that Banty Singh is named in the F.I.R. but Sunil Kumar Paswan is not named in the F.I.R. No one has been injured so the offence under Section 307 of the I.P.C. is not made out against these petitioners. It is also submitted that petitioner no.1 has no criminal antecedent and there is one matrimonial case is pending against the petitioner no. 2. It is also submitted that co-accused have been granted

anticipatory bail by learned court below on the basis of compromise petition on 25.05.2022.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail petition.

Accordingly, the petitioners, namely, Banty Singh, Sunil Kumar Paswan, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jamshedpur in connection with Bagbera P.S. Case No. 20 of 2022.
