Heard, Mr. Manoj Tandon, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Nehala Sharmin, learned counsel for the State.

Mr. Manoj Tandon, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the same set of occurrence, departmental proceeding has been initiated against the petitioner in which he has been exonerated by the enquiry officer however certain punishment has been inflicted upon the petitioner which has been challenged by the petitioner before this court by filing writ petition which was allowed which was further examined by the Hon'ble Division Bench and the same was remanded before the Disciplinary Authority.

It appears that this case is of the year, 2016, still Final Form has not been submitted neither the reason has been disclosed in the counter-affidavit. This Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to raise all the grounds at the appropriate stage.
