Apprehending his arrest, petitioner- Sunil Pasi has moved this Court for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail in connection with G.O.C.R. Case No. 33 of 2019 registered under Sections 33 and 63 of the Indian Forest Act.

Heard the parties.

As per the prosecution case, the petitioner has encroached the forest land and has constructed a house on it.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has no concern with the forest land and he does not claim any part of it.

The Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel and the fact as discussed above, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. Hence, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of three weeks from the date of this order, the petitioner named above shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.

The petitioner will cooperate in the investigation and will appear on notice under Section 41A of Cr. P.C.
