2/31.01.2022 The lawyers have no objection with regard to the proceeding, which has been held through video conferencing today at 10.30 A.M. They have no complaint in respect to the audio and video clarity and quality.

Defects, pointed out by the office, are hereby ignored for the present.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant, who opposes the prayer for bail.

The petitioner is praying for grant of bail as he is in custody since 05.09.2021, for allegedly committing offence punishable under Sections 323, 494, 498A, 506, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the husband. The allegation of assault and torture is general and omnibus in nature against all the accused persons. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case.

Considering the period of custody and the fact that charge sheet has already been submitted in this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail as no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner in custody. Accordingly, petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Ramgarh in connection with Barlanga P.S. Case No. 12 of 2021.
