- 17. **1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
 - 2. Mr. S. Swain, learned counsel appearing for the appellant has submitted that no instruction could be obtained from the appellant he is not in a position to participate in the proceeding.
 - 3. In the order dated 17.11.2022, we had clearly mentioned that if today there was no instruction, this court would be compelled to pass the appropriate order.
 - 4. Mr. S. Mishra, learned counsel appearing for the respondent has submitted that the appellant is deliberately avoiding the proceeding as he has been directed by this court to pay a sum of Rs.15 lakhs. But the said sum has not been paid. A period of one year has already elapsed.
 - **5.** Therefore, the appeal stands dismissed for non-prosecution.

6. To avert any confusion, we make it clear that because of this order, the original decree will be in force, not the intermediate order as passed on 16.03.2022.
