- 1. Heard.
- 2. This is an application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.35/2022 registered at Police Station Jhagrakhand, District Koriya (CG) for the offence punishable under Sections 376, 366, 342, 323 of the IPC.
- 3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that on 9.2.2022, when the prosecutrix had gone to Sahvanitola Park, the applicant met and took her near the newly built house of his sister and committed rape. Hence, the offence has been registered.
- 4. Learned for the applicant submits that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the case. He submits that

since the incident came into the knowledge of the mother of the prosecutrix, under the pressure of her family members, the prosecutrix has lodged the FIR. There is no injury on the body of the victim/prosecutrix. The applicant is in jail since 18.2.2022, therefore, learned counsel prays for releasing the applicant on regular bail.

- 5. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State opposes the bail application.
- 6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case particularly considering the nature of allegations, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I am inclined to release the applicant on regular bail.
- 7. Accordingly, the application is allowed and the applicant is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court. He is directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date given by the said Court.
