ORDER

Heard.

By this petition preferred under Article 226 of Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for a direction to the respondent Bank to make payment of encashment of Privileged Leave (P.L) alongwith interest @12% per annum for the delay in making the payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue involved in this petition has already been decided by this Court by order dated 18-01-2019 in Writ Petition 18249/2018 (Mukund Hegde Vs. Narmada Jhabua Gramin Bank and another) despite of which the respondents are not granting the benefit to the petitioner despite him having already made a representation on 30-12-2021. Prayer has been made for a direction to the respondents to decide the petitioner's pending representation within a fixed time period.

Prayer is reasonable, hence is allowed. Respondents are directed to advert



to petitioner's pending representation dated 30-12-2021 (Annexure-P-6) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a reasoned and a speaking order and by taking into consideration the order passed in the case of Mukund Hegde (supa). Needless to say that if the petitioner is found entitled then the necessary benefits be released to him within a period of one month from the date of decision.

With the aforesaid, without expressing any opinion on merits, the petition stands disposed off.
