This petition coming on for admission this day, the court passed the following:

## **ORDER**

In the instant petition, a direction is being sought to the respondents to revise the pensionary benefits of the petitioner w.e.f. from 01.01.2006 and to pay all arrears of salary and pension with interest.

The petitioner was appointed in the year 1980 on the post of Staff Nurse. She retired on 31.03.2007 from the post of Staff Nurse, District Hospital, Jhabua. The State Govt. has passed an order on 01.01.2006 for giving the benefits of the sixth pay commission to the government employees. The petitioner has submitted various representations for giving benefit of 6th pay commission, arrears of salary and revision of pension, but no heed is paid to the aforesaid representations.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, I deem it proper to dispose off the



writ petition with a direction to the respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with the law within a period of two months from the date of communication of the order.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed off.
