## **ORDER**

Counsel for petitioner submits that in earlier round of litigation he raised an issue that the land acquisition proceedings have lapsed. The said writ petition was dismissed and the petitioner remained unsuccessful before the Supreme Court in the SLP as well. However, the Apex Court observed that the petitioner can approach for the remedy of delayed release of compensation. It is submitted that in the light of the observation passed by the Apex court, the petitioner has submitted an application before the Collector on 28/9/2021 Annexure P/3, however, the same has not been decided and it is pending.
