

The present petition is filed by the petitioner who is 90 years old seeking nomination of his son aged 48 years who is mentally disabled as his beneficiary after his death. Earlier, the petitioner's wife was nominated but she had passed away in the year 2016. The petitioner has prayed a direction to the respondent No.2 and 3 to issue amended pension payment order (PPO) nominating his mentally disabled son instead of his wife. It is submitted that all the formalities were completed and by communication dated 2.3.2019 issued from the office of the Commissioner, Higher Education, Bhopal to Registrar of the University it was stated that the nomination form of the university is not signed by the competent officer. In reply to the said intimation, the university vide letter dated 1.4.2019 (Annexure P/30) had written to the respondent No.2 Commissioner, Higher Education, Bhopal that nomination form of the petitioner has been duly signed by the competent officer and the same was forwarded for further action. Till today office of the respondent No.2 had not taken any action in the matter for issuing amended PPO.

Counsel for State was granted time on 3.8.2022, 6.9.2022, 12,9.2022 and 20.9.2022 to seek instructions in the matter and to file short reply.

Today, counsel for respondent State submits that instructions have been received and letter dated 2.3.2019 issued by the office of the Commissioner, Higher Education has been sent to her to submit that the nomination form of the petitioner is not signed by the competent officer.

After hearing learned counsel for petitioner and the respondents and on perusal of the communication dated 1.4.2019 (Annexure P/30), it is crystal clear that the nomination form of the petitioner has been duly signed by the competent officer of the university and the same has been forwarded to the

office of the respondent No.2 for further action. The lackadiscal attitude on the part of the respondent No.2 in such matter is highly deprecated. Petitioner is a retired employee and is seeking a direction for nomination of his son in the nomination form.

Considering the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and the respondent No.2 is directed to issue revised PPO within a period of one month from the date of communication by nominating the petitioner's son Ajit Berde as nominee. Revised PPO and necessary directions be issued to the concerned authorities for payment forthwith.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition is allowed and disposed off.
