Heard on I.A.No.10876/2021, which is an application for condonation of delay in filing this appeal.

The writ appeal is barred by 1185 days.

For the reasons assigned in the application, this Court does not find any good reason to allow the application for condonation of delay specially when this appeal itself has been filed against an interlocutory order whereby only the petition (Writ Petition No.7733/2018) filed by the petitioner/appellant has been admitted.

Counsel for the appellant has been submitted that the in the aforesaid writ petition the reply has also been filed by the respondents.

In such circumstances, this appeal is not only barred by limitation but it is also not maintainable. However, considering the fact that the reply has been filed by the respondents in W.P. No.7733/2018 the petitioner/appellant shall be at liberty to apply for early hearing of the writ petition.

With the aforesaid, the writ appeal stands disposed of.
