**ORDER**

This is repeat (second) application under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. filed on behalf of the applicant in connection with Crime No. 26/2022 registered at Police Station - Sagore, Dist. Dhar (M.P.) under Section 307 of IPC.

The earlier bail application was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to revive the application after the statement of the complainant. The statement of the complainant Radheshyam and eyewitness Smt. Kali Bai have been recorded. They have supported the prosecution case. It is stated that the applicant has caused injury on the neck of the complainant with the help of *falia* (sharp edged

weapon).

Considering the statement of the complainant and the eyewitness, I am not inclined to grant bail to the applicant. The application is **dismissed**.
