**ORDER**

The present application has been filed for the restoration of First Appeal No.118/2020 which was dismissed for non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 11.2.2022 pursuant to which the order of the Registrar (J-I) dated

1.4.2022 has dismissed the first appeal without reference to the Board.

Heard on I.A. No.11319/2022, which is an application for condonation of delay, which reveals that the application for restoration has been filed after a delay of 71 days.

For the reasons stated in paragraph nos.2 to 4 of the said I.A., the same is allowed and the delay of 71 days in filing the restoration application is condoned.

Heard on the MCC.

In view of what has been stated in paragraph nos.2 to 7, the MCC is allowed.
