HONOURABLE SMT. JUSTICE V.SUJATHA WRIT PETITION No.28503 of 2015

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief:

"...to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction declaring action of the 3rd Respondent in interfering with petitioner's right, title, possession and enjoyment of the property without any notice or due process of law in respect of the land to an extent of admeasuring Ac.1.50 in Sy. No.33/3 of Turpu Takkellapadu village, J.Panguluru Mandal, Prakasam District by trying to make illegal entries to the above land as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to law and pass such other order or orders which are deem fit and proper..."

- 2. When the matter came up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner reiterated the contents urged in the writ petition.
- 3. On the other hand, learned Government Pleader for Revenue placed a copy of instructions of the 3rd respondent-Tahsildar, vide Rc.B/234/2022, dated 28.11.2022, wherein it is stated that the Tahsildar and other staff of Mandal Revenue

Office never interfered with the possession and enjoyment of the

petitioner's subject land and it seems that there was a dispute

between the petitioner and the 4th respondent.

4. It is also stated that the petitioner had filed this writ

petition suspecting that the 4th respondent is trying to get his

name incorporated in the webland and to get Pattadar Passbook

and Title Deed in his favour, but, the 4th respondent's name was

not incorporated in the webland and at present the petitioner's

son is in possession and enjoyment of the subject land.

5. In view of the above instructions of the 3rd

respondent, nothing survives for further adjudication and no

order needs to be passed in this writ petition.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition is closed. There shall

be no order as to costs.

Consequently, miscellaneous petitions, pending if any, shall

stand closed.
