THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURESH REDDY

WRIT PETITION No. 63 OF 2013 (Taken up through video conferencing)

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

"For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the above named petitioner prays that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly in the nature of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent authorities in not considering the claim of the petitioner for taking into consideration of her appointment as on 27-09-2003 and to grant all attending service benefits, pensionary benefits, arrears of salary etc., as arbitrary, illegal, violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and contrary to law, consequently direct the respondents to consider the petitioner appointment as on 27-09-2003 and grant all service benefits forthwith and to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case."

- 2. Heard both learned counsel.
- 3. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner made a representation on 31-05-2011 to respondent No. 1 but the latter has not passed any orders so far on the said representation and therefore, learned counsel requests this Court to issue a direction to respondent No. 1 to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders thereon within a timeframe.

4. Recording the said submission of learned counsel for the

petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No. 1

to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 31-05-2011 and

pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law within a

period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order

and duly communicate the decision so taken to the petitioner.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in

consequence. No costs.
