By way of instant application, prayer has been
made on behalf of applicants/ appellants No.1 and 2 for
release of the award amount lying deposited in the Registry
of this Court. No reply is intended to be filed on behalf of the
non-applicants-respondents.

Averments contained in the application, which is
duly supported by an affidavit as well as documents annexed
therewith, reveals that appeal bearing FAO No.97 of 2017
having been filed by the applicants-appellants stands finally
decided by this Court vide judgment dated 14.03.2022.
Perusal of aforesaid judgment reveals that during the
pendency of the appeal parties have resolved to settle their
dispute amicably inter se, whereby non-applicant/
respondent/ insurance company has agreed to pay sum of
₹4,80,000/- over and above sum of ₹7,41,200/-awarded by
the Tribunal below. Since aforesaid judgment passed by this
has attained finality, there appears to be no impediment in
accepting the prayer made in the application.

Consequently, in view of the above, the present
application is allowed and Registry is directed to release the

award amount alongwith up-to-date interest falling in the shares of applicants/appellants No.1 and 2, by remitting the same in their saving bank accounts, details whereof are given in para-4 of the application, subject to the verification by the accounts Branch. Needless to say, remaining amount falling in the share of applicant/appellant No.3, who is minor, shall be kept in FDRs till further order. The application stands disposed of.
