Order dated 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, passed by learned Mediator, clearly reveals that parties to lis have almost settled their dispute, but before passing final orders, learned Mediator is required to peruse the record with regard to accounts held by late Sh. Ram Chand in various banks as well as LIC.

Vide order dated 8.11.2021, this Court had directed Managers, Punjab National Bank, Dadasiba, Tehsil Dadasiba, District Kangra, State Bank of India, Nangal Chowk, The Dadasiba, District Kangra, H.P., Kangra Central Cooperative bank Dadasiba, District Kangra, H.P. and Branch Manager, Life Insurance Corporation of India Branch Office Dehra Gopipur to file affidavit in sealed cover, disclosing therein actual balance amount in the accounts of late Sh. Ram Chand. Pursuant to aforesaid order, details of banks as well as accounts held by late Sh. Ram Chand, have been made available in sealed cover.

Aforesaid record may be sent to learned Mediator, who is authorized to open the seal and peruse the record and pass appropriate orders. Since, learned Mediator, has already fixed the matter for 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2022, Registry of this Court is directed to make available aforesaid record to the learned Mediator on that day, enabling him to pass appropriate orders.

Learned counsel representing the parties undertake to  
advise learned Mediator with regard to passing of instant order.
