The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners seek leave to withdraw this petition.

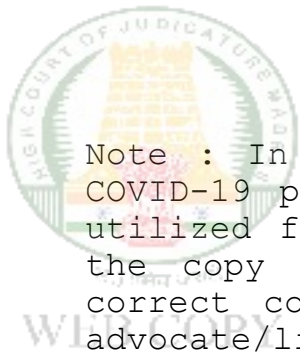
