## AWARD

Compensation Awarded by the LAO/ Land Acquisition Officer & Revenue Divisional Officer, Narayanpet	The LAO/ Land Acquisition Officer & Revenue Divisional Officer, Narayanpet, has passed the Award in File No.892/2008, dated 18-11-2010 awarding Rs.55,000/- per acre.
Compensation Awarded by the Senior Civil Judge at Narayanpet	The reference court/Senior Civil Judge, Narayanpet, has passed the Award in LAOP.No. 24 of 2011, dated 04-12-2012, awarding compensation amount at the rate of Rs.300/- per square yard along with statutory benefits.
Compensation Awarded (Settlement Reached) in the Lok Adalat.	The Claimants have agreed to forego 15% of the enhanced compensation granted by the reference court/Senior Civil Judge, Narayanpet and the Appellant/LAO has accepted for confirmation of order of the reference court subject to deduction of 15% of the enhanced compensation. The order of reference court/Senior Civil Judge, Narayanpet is modified deducting 15% of the enhanced compensation amount granted by the Reference Court/Senior Civil Judge, Narayanpet and remaining order of reference court is intact and confirmed.




In token of consent for the above settlement and award, the parties and their counsel have signed this award in our presence.

In terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties, this case stands disposed of.
