Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent.No.6 and his officers, in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioners property and proceeding to dispossess the petitioner from his property, comprising land admeasuring Ac.0-20.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1, Ac.1-05.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1 and Ac.3-01.Gts in Sy.No.292B/2 situated at Husnabad Village and Mandal, Siddipet District, as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, violation of Art.14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent.No.6 and his officers not to interfere with the said property of the petitioner in any manner and direct the Respondent.No.6 not to dispossess the petitioner from his property comprising land admeasuring Ac.0-20.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1, Ac.1-05.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1 and Ac.3-01.Gts in Sy.No.292B/2 situated at Husnabad Village and Mandal, Siddipet District, without insisting in the interest of justice.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2022**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant Interim Direction to the Respondent.No.6 and his officers not to interfere with the property of the petitioner in any manner and direct the Respondent.No.6 not to dispossess the petitioner from his property comprising land admeasuring Ac.0-20.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1, Ac.1-05.Gts in Sy.No.292A/1 and Ac.3-01.Gts in Sy.No.292B/2 situated at Husnabad Village and Mandal, Siddipet District, without insisting in the interest of justice.

The Court made the following: ORDER

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE T. VINOD KUMAR**

**Writ Petition No.23567 of 2022**

**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed to declare the action of the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent and his officers in interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner's property and trying to dispossess him from his land admeasuring Ac.0.20 guntas in Sy.No.292A/1, Ac.1.05 guntas, in Sy.No.292A/1 and Acs.3.01 guntas in Sy.No.292B/2 situated at Husnabad Village and Mandal, Siddipet District, as illegal, arbitrary and consequently, direct the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent and his officers not to interfere with the subject land in any manner.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondents, and with their consent, the writ petition is taken up for hearing and disposal at the stage of admission.

3. Petitioner contends that the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent, being a police officer, without having any power in his official capacity, is interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioner over the subject land and removed the shed by colluding with unsocial elements and kept him in the police station and threatened him to vacate the said land.

4. Learned Government Pleader for Home has placed before this Court the Written Instructions, dt.11.05.2022, under the signature of the Sub-Inspector of Police, PS Husnabad, Siddipet Commissionerate, enclosing therewith copies of FIR, complaint dt.04.01.2022 and charge sheet etc. and the same is taken on record.

5. By the said written instructions, while denying the allegations of the petitioner, it is stated that three cases have been registered against the

petitioner. In respect of the above said lands, on the file of the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent police station, vide Crime Nos.6, 25 and 37 of 2022, and when the petitioner created nuisance and Law and Order problem in respect of the subject lands, the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent submitted a report to the Tahsildar, Husnabad, on 30.04.2022, and in turn, the Tahsildar, passed order of bound over the petitioner for good behaviour vide M.C.No.C/195/22, dt.30.04.2022.

6. Further, by the said written instructions, it is stated that except conducting investigation into the above criminal cases by visiting scene of offence, the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent did not harass, threaten, detain or interfere with the above said lands, nor has taken coercive action in any manner.

7. Having regard to the above said written instructions, whereby the respondents have categorically stated that except conducting investigation into the crimes registered, the authorities are not interfering in the civil dispute or trying to dispossess the petitioner, no further orders need be passed in this Writ Petition and it is accordingly closed.

8. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed. No order as to costs.
