Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No 2 in not including allowing the Petitioners institution (which is already recognized by the 2nd Respondent Board) for the purpose of Admission of students into Para Medical courses for the Academic Year 2021-23 in the Notification No. 551/TSPMB/Admissions/AY2021-22 dated 22/11/2021 and the subsequent Circular No. 551/TSPMB/Admissions/2021-22 dated 17/12/2021 is illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of Constitution of India , besides violative of principles of natural justice and contrary to the provisions of A.P. Para Medical Board Act(Act 38 of 2006) and consequently direct the respondent No 2 to forthwith include the Petitioner Institution in the admission notification dt 22/11/2021 and the subsequent Circular dt. 17/12/2021 so as to enable the Petitioner Institution to admit the students for the academic year 2021-2023 in various Para Medical Diploma Courses.

IA NO: 1 OF 2021

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No 2 to forthwith include the Petitioner's Institution in the admission notification dt 22/11/2021 and the subsequent Circular dt. 17-12-2021 so as to enable the Petitioner's Institution to admit the students for the academic year 2021-2023 in various Para Medical Diploma Courses as per the recognition granted by the 2nd respondent, pending disposal of the Writ Petition.

IA NO: 1 OF 2022

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to vacate the interim orders dated 28/12/2021 passed in IA.No. 1 of 2021 in W.P.No. 36599 of 2021 and dismiss the writ petition.
