Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 119 dated 19.09.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ghanie Kek Bangar, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 14.12.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 06.01.2022 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Batala has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Batala.

Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any influence, threat and coercion.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 119 dated 19.09.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ghanie Kek Bangar, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
