This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 24.09.2021 in case FIR No.0835 dated 16.11.2015, registered for offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Karnal Sadar, District Karnal passed by the Trial Court whereby owing to absence of the petitioner his bail was cancelled and bail bonds were ordered to be forfeited.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 07.03.2022 the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 24.03.2022 and was admitted to bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/-.

As per the pleadings the petitioner has been regularly attending to the trial, however, owing to mis-communication between the petitioner and his counsel on account of bereavement in the family of the

counsel for the petitioner, petitioner could not appear on the fateful day i.e. 24.09.2021 before the Trial Court.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already presented himself before the trial Court and pursuant to the order passed by this Court he has been ordered to be released on bail.

Counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that after 16.08.2022 the matter has been posted for 20.09.2022 for evidence of the prosecution.

Consequently since the petitioner is also before the trial Court nothing more remains to be adjudicated in the present case. Order dated 07.03.2022 is made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall keep on appearing before the trial Court and he shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Poor Patients Welfare Fund being maintained by the PGIMER, Chandigarh.

Petitions stands disposed off.
