**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.42 dated 04.02.2020 registered against them at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur, under Sections 323/325/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 15.12.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Satpal @ Sonu, Barjinder Singh @ Baljinder Singh @ Pinki, Ram Khilari and Duryodhan as well as

of complainant Mool Chand have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Mool Chand in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, has specifically opined that the compromise effected amongst the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.42 dated 04.02.2020 registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur, under Sections 323/325/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
