Case heard by video conferencing.

This petition has been filed seeking quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondents no.2 and 3, of FIR no.94, dated 05.03.2020 (as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom), registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406 of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition

Pursuant to the order dated March 25, 2021, the report of the learned SDJM, Kanina, dated 23.04.2021, is on record, stating to the effect that the complainant-respondent no.2, Sandeep Kumar, as also respondent no.3, Abhimanyu, came present before that court (as did the petitioners), with the said respondents having made a joint statement to the effect that the matter had been

compromised with the accused persons, without any pressure, with the petitioners also having made similar statements.

As per the opinion of that court, the compromise arrived at between the parties seems to be of their own free will.

A reply has been filed to the petition by the DSP, Kanina, dated 17.06.2021, which is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the said reply also the matter was compromised between the parties, and there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioners.

That being so, looking at the nature of offences, the petition is allowed and FIR no.94, dated 05.03.2020, registered at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406 of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
