**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

The present writ petition has been filed primarily by asserting that the private respondents herein have approached this Court by filing ***CWP No.21719 of 2020*** titled as '***Parmal Singh and Another versus State of Haryana and Others***' and have got an interim order in their favour i.e. status quo on 27.01.2021 without disclosing the fact that they have been actually evicted from the land and in pursuance to the said interim order, they have again taken possession of the land which had been earlier handed over to the Gram Panchayat.

The assertion of the petitioner through the present writ petition cannot be accepted in the light of the fact that it could amount to passing a contrary order, when the case is already pending before this Court, which relates to the same piece of land and arises out of the same orders, which are the subject matter of the present writ petition. Even, the parties are the same except the petitioner.

The writ petition, therefore, in the present form is not maintainable and is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before this Court in ***CWP No.21719 of 2020***, which is pending in this Court for adjudication, bringing the facts as has been highlighted in the present petition to the notice of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above observations.
