This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 276 dated 5.6.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 379B, 435 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kheripul, District Faridabad.

This Court vide order dated 7.7.2022, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI-Om Parkash submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating. She further submits that i10 car and *danda* have been recovered.

Though the complainant is not impleaded as party, Mr. M. K. Sood, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant. He opposes the prayer for confirmation of interim anticipatory bail. He submits that the petitioner was specifically named in the FIR and it has wrongly been stated in the earlier order that he was not involved in any other case.

The contention is that he is involved in three more cases.

Considering that the petitioner has joined the investigation, recovery has been made, his custody is not required, he is being named in the FIR cannot be a ground to deprive his personal liberty, the interim bail granted is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
