Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.312 dated 13.06.2019 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 28.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel contends that a sum of Rs.27,090/- was deducted from the account of the complainant in an online transaction purported to be made at the instance of the representative of naukri.com and the person involved in the crime has already been arrested and amount has also been recovered from him. It is further pointed out that the mobile phone mentioned in the FIR used by the accused does not belong to the petitioner, therefore, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be necessary at this stage.*

*Notice of motion for 28.02.2022.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing*

*personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by Inspector Bijender Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 28.10.2021 is made absolute.
