			Mr. Mohd.Safdar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Pratiroop Pande, learned AGA for the State. This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction in the nature of mandamus commanding and directing respondent nos.1 and 2 to give protection to the petitioners. Petitioners are present before the Court through video conferencing; according to them, they got married on 15.12.2020 as per Muslim rituals; both the petitioners belong to the same faith; however, their marriage is opposed by their parents; petitioners seek police protection from the Court as they have a threat perception at the hands of respondent no.3. As per the record, both the petitioners are major; their Nikah certificate is also on record. In the interest of justice and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another reported in (2006) 5 SCC 475, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Haridwar is directed to coordinate with, and give suitable directions to the concerned SHO, to provide necessary protection to the petitioners.
