			It is argued by learned Senior Advocate for
			the accused that he is languishing in jail since
			19.02.2020. There is no evidence against him.
			Co-accused Deepak Sharma has already been
			enlarged on bail by this Court. On the ground of
			parity, the accused is also entitled for bail.
			Per contra, learned counsel for the State
			opposed for bail but fairly submitted that after
			the investigation, the statement of Deepak
			Sharma (co-accused) was recorded who
			disclosed about the present accused. On the
			basis of the statement given by co-accused,
			present accused Parvej was arrested.
			The FIR was lodged on 11.09.2019 at the
			Police Station Nehru Colony, Dehradun. As per
			the FIR, in the month of November, 2018, the
			accused kidnapped Ajay Verma @ Rinku and
			murdered him in the area of Rajasthan.
			Accused Deepak Sharma was arrested and
			the statement was recorded under 161 Cr.P.C.
			He disclosed the name of the present accused,
			and on the basis of the said statement accused
			was arrested. There is no prima facie evidence
			on record against the accused regarding
			involvement in the crime except the statement of
			co-accused Deepak Sharma. Co-accused Deepak

Sharma has been enlarged on bail, and the role of applicant is identical; accordingly without going into merit of the case, it is a fit case for bail at this stage on parity. The bail application is thus, allowed and the applicant is directed to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
