Having been implicated in FIR/Case Crime No. 33 of 2021, under Sections 420 & 120 B IPC & Section 66 D of IT Act, PS Cyber P.S., District Dehradun, the present bail application has been moved on behalf of the accused applicant. Learned Counsel for the applicant would submit that the applicant has been falsely implicated; that the applicant is not named in the FIR; that there is no independent public witness of the alleged offence; that the applicant did not received any money; that the alleged offence is triable by the Magistrate; there is no criminal history in his credit and he is languishing in jail since 14.02.2022. Learned State Counsel although opposed the bail application, but admitted that no money was transferred in the account of the accused/applicant. He also admitted that the applicant has no criminal history in his credit. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and without any comment on the final merits of the case, the Court is of the view that the applicant deserves bail at this stage. Consequently, the bail application is allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail
			on his executing a personal bond and

furnishing two sureties, each in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Court concerned. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
