| | | | <p>BA1 No.911 of 2022 <u>Hon'ble R.C. Khulbe, J.</u> Mr. Gaurav Singh, learned counsel for the applicant. Mr. P.S. Uniyal and Mr. Rakesh Joshi, learned B.H. for the State. Accused–Arjun Yadav has sought his release on bail in connection with Case Crime/FIR No.30/2021, u/s 27(A) of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered at P.S. G.R.P. Haridwar, District Haridwar. It is argued that on the basis of statement of co-accused, the applicant was implicated in the present case while in other case crime no.33 of 2021 and 34 of 2021 he has been enlarged on bail; he is ready to furnish the sureties and may be granted bail. Per contra, learned counsel for the State opposed for bail but fairly admitted the above facts. Admittedly, the name of the accused came into light after recording the statement of co-accused, from whose possession contraband article was recovered; there is no other evidence except the confessional statement of co-accused; the accused has already been enlarged on bail in case crime no.33 of 2021 and 34 of 2021 registered under the N.D.P.S. Act; accordingly, without making any comment on the merits, it is a fit case for bail at this stage. The bail application is thus, allowed and the applicant is directed to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.
