However, for the sake of brevity, facts of WPSS No. 1511 of 2018 alone are being considered.</p> <p>Petitioner was appointed in DRDA, which was registered as Society under Societies Registration Act, 1860. Subsequently, in the year 2015, pursuant to a Government decision, she was conferred status of Government employee.</p> <p>In this writ petition, petitioner has challenged the order of transfer passed</p> |

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court passed stay order on 14.06.2018 in favour of petitioner.</p> <p>On the strength of interim order, petitioner is still serving at the same place, where she was earlier serving.</p> <p>Since petitioner has served at the same place on the strength of interim order for four years and before that also, she was serving there, therefore, this Court is of the considered opinion that this writ petition has become infructuous, by efflux of time, as normally duration of posting of a Government Servant at a particular place, is three years, in Transfer Act, 2017.</p> <p>These writ petitions were filed in 2018 and the relief, as claimed in writ petitions, cannot be granted at this belated stage.</p> <p>Accordingly, writ petitions are dismissed as infructuous.</p> <p>Interim orders, in all the petitions, stand vacated.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.) 27.05.2022</p> |
