Applicant Alok Kumar is in judicial custody in FIR No.0111 of 2021, under Sections 2/3 U.P. Gangsters and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986, Police Station Jhankaiya, District- Udham Singh Nagar. He has sought his release on bail.

- 2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
- 3. According to the FIR, based on 2 criminal cases ((i)FIR No.55 of 2021, under Section 8/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Section 60 of the U.P. Excise Act, 1910, Section 51B of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, Section 188/269/270 IPC and Section 3 of Epidemic Act, 1897 and (ii) FIR No.81 of

2021, under Sections 8/20/60 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985), the instant FIR has been lodged against the applicant.

- 4. It is argued by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant has not committed any offence; in the cases, on the basis of which the instant case has been registered, the applicant has already been enlarged on bail; he is not a previous convict.
- 5. Learned State Counsel would submit that the applicant is a habitual offender.
- 6. Having considered, this Court is of the view that it is a case fit for bail and the applicant deserves to be enlarged on bail.
- 7. The bail application is allowed.
- 8. Let the applicant be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
