## Hon'ble Alok Kumar Verma, J.

This S.C.C. Revision has been preferred against the order dated 25.10.2021, passed by the Additional District Judge, Kotdwar, District Pauri Garhwal, in SCC Suit No.07 of 2019, "Mujiburrehman vs. Zubair Ahamd, whereby, the right to defense of the revisionist/defendant has been struck off by allowing the application of the respondent/plaintiff under the provisions of Order 15 Rule 5 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

- 2. Heard Mr. V.K. Kaparwan with Mr. Yogesh Pant, the learned counsel for the revisionists and Mr. K.H. Gupta, the learned counsel for the respondent.
- 3. The learned counsel for the revisionists submitted that the revisionists are ready to deposit all

the dues, they have till today. They further submitted

that the revisionists undertake that all the dues will be

deposited by the revisionists before the concerned court

within one month from today.

**4.** The learned counsel for the respondent

submitted that in view of the oral undertaking, given by

the revisionists, the present revision may be disposed of

with a direction to the concerned court to decide the

matter expeditiously.

**5.** The learned counsel appearing for the parties

submitted that the parties will not seek any unnecessary

adjournments.

**6.** In the above circumstances and in the interest

of justice, impugned order dated 25.10.2021, passed by

the Additional District Judge, Kotdwar, District Pauri

Garhwal in SCC Suit No.07 of 2019, "Mujiburrehman vs.

Zubair Ahamd", is set aside. The Additional District

Judge, Kotdwar, District Pauri Garhwal is requested to

take the matter and decide the same as expeditiously as

possible without granting any unnecessary adjournments,

but, in accordance with law.

7. The present Civil Revision is disposed of,

accordingly.
