Bisht, Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State of Uttarakhand / respondent nos. 1 to 3.</p> <p>Mr. Rajesh Sharma, Advocate for respondent no. 4.</p> <p>Heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>Petitioner retired from the post of Revenue Sub Inspector on 31.07.2019. Since the amount of G.P.F. was not being released to petitioner, therefore, he has filed this writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to release the amount of G.P.F. with interest.</p> <p>Time was granted to learned State Counsel as well as learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 4 to get instructions in the matter.</p> <p>Today, Mr. P.C. Bisht, learned State counsel has produced in Court a letter</p>

		<p>issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Khatima, on 29.11.2022. Perusal of the said letter reveals that a sum of Rs. 8,98,000/- has been released to the petitioner against total G.P.F. amount of Rs. 9,98,447/-.</p> <p>Learned State counsel submitted that 90% of the G.P.F. amount has already been released to petitioner and the remaining 10% has to be released by the Office of Accountant General.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for petitioner was granted time to get instructions. On instructions, she submitted that petitioner has received 90% of the amount and she prays that direction be issued to the Competent Authority to release the remaining 10% of the G.P.F. amount.</p> <p>Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent no. 4 to take necessary steps to ensure that the remaining 10% G.P.F. amount is released to petitioner within four weeks from today.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Manoj Kumar Tiwari, J.) 30.11.2022</p>
