			Since the amount of G.P.F. was not
			being released to petitioner, therefore,
			he has filed this writ petition seeking a
			direction to the respondents to release
			the amount of G.P.F. with interest.
			Time was granted to learned State
			Counsel as well as learned counsel
			appearing for respondent no. 4 to get
			instructions in the matter.
			Today, Mr. P.C. Bisht, learned State
			counsel has produced in Court a letter

issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Khatima, on 29.11.2022. Perusal of the said letter reveals that a sum of Rs. 8,98,000/- has been released to the petitioner against total G.P.F. amount of Rs. 9,98,447/-.

Learned State counsel submitted that 90% of the G.P.F. amount has already been released to petitioner and the remaining 10% has to be released by the Office of Accountant General.

Learned counsel for appearing petitioner was granted time to get instructions. On instructions. she submitted that petitioner has received 90% of the amount and she prays that direction be issued to the Competent Authority to release the remaining 10% of the G.P.F. amount.

Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent no. 4 to take necessary steps to ensure that the remaining 10% G.P.F. amount is released to petitioner within four weeks from today.
