C.S.C. for the State.</p> <p>Mr. Vinay Bhatt, the learned counsel for respondent nos. 2 and 3.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The limited grievance raised by the petitioner is that though his pay was re-fixed in the light of the Seventh Central Pay Commission Report, and has received last amended pay certificate in the month of August 2022, the arrears accruing on account of re-fixation of pay for the period from 01.01.2016 to 01.09.2021, when the petitioner was superannuated, has not been paid till date, despite the petitioner's application made on 09.09.2022.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 2 and 3 states that the said respondents are running in losses, and are not in a position to pay the arrears due to the petitioner.</p> <p>Inability to make payment cannot be cited by the said respondents as a reason for non-payment of the petitioner's admitted dues, since the respondents are State instrumentalities.</p> <p>In that view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of directing respondents to make payment of the arrears of pay due to the petitioner positively within three month from today.</p> |
