			Mr. Sanjay Kumar, learned counsel holding brief of Mr. Tapan Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr. Suyash Pant, learned Standing Counsel for the State. This is the third journey of the petitioner to this Court. He had filed a Writ Petition No. 1409 of 2020 (M/S), which was dismissed with almost the same prayer for settlement of the dispute and disposal of the representation etc. There was a dismissal on 22.09.2020. The petitioner approached the Division Bench in an intra court appeal bearing Special Appeal No. 220 of 2022, which was also dismissed by the Division Bench of this Court on the ground that the petitioner has an alternative and efficacious remedy. Now by clever pleading, the petitioner has modulated his prayer and has sought the same relief by filing this writ petition. This court is of the opinion that this is a frivolous and vexacious writ petition and should be dismissed at the threshold. Hence, the writ petition is dismissed in limine with a cost of Rs. 10,000/ The cost shall be deposited before the High Court Bar Association, Nainital, within seven days, failing which, it shall be recovered from the petitioner as arrears of land revenue.
