			2. Issue a writ order or direction in the
			nature of mandamus directing the
			respondent no. 2 to not to arrest the
			petitioner in pursuance of the impugned
			FIR dated 8.11.2022 registered as
			FIR/case Crime No. 274 of 2022 U/s 420,
			467, 468, 471 & 120-B of IPC at Police
			Station Kotwali Kotdwar, District Pauri
			Garhwal lodged by the respondent no. 3."
			The petitioner is not named in the FIR.
			Therefore, the learned counsel for the State was
			directed to take instructions regarding the material
			available against the present petitioner in
			commission of the crime. The named accused
			persons sold the land to the complainant by
			impersonating Pradeep and Rohit on the basis of
			forged Aadhar Card, Pan Card and Revenue
			Records, and it has revealed during the course of
			investigation that it is the present petitioner, who
			has prepared the forged documents.

In that view of the matter, this Court is of the opinion that there is sufficient material available against the petitioner to allow the investigation to go on without any hindrance. Hence, the writ application is without any merit. The same is, therefore, dismissed. Interim order stands vacated.
