			present petition to seek a direction to

			The perusal of the petition shows
			that there appears to be some dispute
			between the petitioner and his
			neighbourers i.e. respondent nos.3 to 6.
			For resolution of such disputes, it
			is open to the petitioner to initiate
			civil or other proceedings before the
			appropriate Court. However, there is
			no doubt that it is the responsibility of
			the State to ensure the safety and
			security of every citizen.
			It is for the respondent-authorities
			to ensure that law and order and
			peace in the area is maintained.
			We, therefore, dispose of this
			petition with direction to respondent
			nos.1 and 2 to make an assessment
			of the threat perceived by the
			petitioner emanating from respondent
			nos.3 to 6 and to take appropriate
			steps to ensure that there is no

breach of peace, law and order in the area where the parties reside. The S.H.O. P.S. Kichha, District Udham Singh Nagar shall call the petitioner and respondent nos.3 to 6 and counsel them not to take law into their hands. With the above directions, the petition stands disposed of.
