Kotwali Haridwar, District Haridwar has sought his release on bail.</p> <p>It is argued by the learned counsel that the accused has falsely been implicated in the offence; he has no concern with the crime; he is languishing in jail since 05.11.2022; co-accused Istaqar has been granted bail by this Court on 12.3.2021; he is ready to furnish the sureties; and may be granted bail on parity.</p> <p>Per contra learned State Counsel opposed for bail but fairly admitted that co-accused has been granted bail.</p> <p>Since the above named co-accused has been granted bail by this Court and the role assigned to the applicant is also similar, accordingly, without going into the merit of the case, it is a fit case for bail at this stage on parity.</p> <p>The bail application is, therefore, allowed and the applicant-accused is directed to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned.</p> <p>Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(R.C.
