The instant criminal misc. petition has been preferred by the complainant seeking fair investigation in connection with FIR No. 105/2019 registered at Police Station Lambaharisingh, Tonk.

At the outset, learned Public Prosecutor submitted a detailed factual report dated 30.01.2022 contending therein that after conducting thorough investigation, a negative final report No. 60/2021 has been chalked out.

In this view of the matter, this Court refrains from passing any comment over the course of the investigation rather the petitioner is better advised to approach the concerned Magistrate and should move a protest petition which may include the payer of
