1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.13/2022 registered at Police Station Beawar City, Ajmer for the offence(s) under Section 420 of IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has deposited the due amount in the Bajaj Finance Ltd. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that he has filed a copy of No Dues Certificate. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. So, petitioner be enlarged on anticipatory bail.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
4. Considering the contentions put-forth by the counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the

case, this court deems it just and proper to allow the anticipatory bail application.

5. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. The S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer, Police Station Beawar City, Ajmer in FIR No.13/2022 is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner-**Himanshu Bambani S/o Shri Ashok Bambani**, he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the following conditions:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
