1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.82/2020 registered at Mahila Thana, Jaipur City (North) for the offence(s) under Sections 498-A, 406 & 323 IPC and Sections 3 & 4 of The Muslim Women (Protection Of Right On Marriage) Act, 2019.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a compromise has been arrived between the parties.
3. Learned counsel for the complainant has not disputed this fact of compromise between the parties.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
5. Considering the contentions put-forth by the counsel for the petitioner and also fact that parties have entered into compromise and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

court deems it just and proper to allow the anticipatory bail application.

6. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is allowed. The S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer, Mahila Thana, Jaipur City (North) in FIR No.82/2020 is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner- **Mohammad Zubeir S/o Sh. Shafakat Husain**, he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the following conditions:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.

7. A compromise has been filed by learned counsel for the parties is taken on record.
