This bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner in connection with FIR No.335/2022 registered at Police Station Udaipurwati, Jhunjhunu wherein he is charged for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 332, 353, 324, 504, 506 & 34 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged offence is triable by Magistrate. Petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents. Counsel submits that cross F.I.R. has already been registered against the complainant-party and the petitioner is in custody since date of his arrest and conclusion of

the trial will take its own time, so indulgence of bail may be granted to the petitioner

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant have opposed the bail application.

Considering the arguments put forward by counsel for the petitioner and looking to the fact that the alleged offence is triable by Magistrate, trial will take its own time to conclude but without expressing any opinion on merits and demerits of the case, I deem it just and appropriate to grant indulgence of bail to the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is ordered that accused-petitioner **Shravan Kumar Son Of Shri Rameshwar Lal** arrested in connection with aforementioned FIR, may be released on bail; provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two surety bonds of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of learned trial Court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
