Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to implead Gram Sabha as respondent no.4 and serve copy to Sri Upendra Kumar, Advocate, appearing on behalf of Gram Sabha during the course of the day.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents no.1 to 3 and Sri Upendra Kumar, learned counsel for the respondent no.4.

The petitioner is before this Court for a direction to respondent no.3-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kerakat, District Jaunpur to decide the Case No.126 of 2013-14 (Computer Case No.T20131436053045) (Mannar Vs. Lalmani) within stipulated period.

It is argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that since the matter is pending consideration he is suffering irreparable loss.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the issue, the present petition stands disposed of finally with a direction to the respondent no.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid case in accordance with law expeditiously and preferably within a period of **four months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order but certainly after giving opportunity to the parties concerned and without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties, if there is no legal impediment.
