Heard Sri Sujeet Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioners and Shri K.R. Singh, learned Chief Standing Counsel alongwith Sri Piyush Shukla, learned Standing Counsel for the State respondents.

Present writ petition has been filed seeking following principal reliefs:-

- (i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing to restrain the respondent authorities not to dispossess/evacuate the petitioners' family illegally and in arbitrary manner.
- (ii) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of a mandamus directing respondent authorities not to construct the expansion of Road from 40 feet/13 metres from middle of the road as prescribed and not to destruct/demolish the house/shop of petitioner which is beyond the 3 metre from red mark."

After substantial arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that the writ petition may be dismissed as not pressed.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty to petitioners to seek such remedies as may be advised.
