Meenakshi Madan Rai, J.

Heard Learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner-University, who submits that the prayer in this Petition *inter alia* was for issuance for an appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing the letter of Respondent No.2, dated 15-11-2019, bearing F.No.81-3/2017 (DEB-IV), vide which the recognition granted to the Petitioner-University to admit students in the distance mode, for the academic year 2019-20 was withdrawn and to restore the approval earlier granted on 27-06-2019.

That, in view of the passage of time the Petition may be disposed of, however the issue arising on account of Annexure P-28, at Page No.211 of this Petition, be left open for decision on merits.
